

GUIDE FOR AUTHORS

1. The journal will accept original research papers, and reviews mainly written in English. Articles must be accompanied by a letter indicating that it is a work neither previously published nor submitted to another publication and that all authors agree with its contents and assigning the publication rights to Rev. Fac. Ing. Univ. Antioquia.
2. Manuscripts should not exceed 20 letter pages and must be typewritten with a font Times New Roman, size 12 pt, double-spaced with 2.5 cm margins, and numbered consecutively at the top right of the page. The manuscript should contain the following in this order: Title (English and Spanish), Abstract (English and Spanish), Keywords (English and Spanish), Introduction, Experimental, Results and Discussion, Conclusions, Acknowledgements (optional), References. Table and figure captions should be placed in the text immediately after being cited. Figures should go at the end of manuscript and an additional file in jpg format should be submitted.
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 - a. Text should be typed in Times New Roman, 12 pt. Special style or formatting should be avoided.
